Assam Jatiya Bidyalay announces— CUET (UG) - 2024 CRASH COURSE

WHY CUET ?

Admissions to central and state government colleges and universities like Delhi University, Cotton University, Tezpur University etc for various undergraduate degree programs (B.Sc, B.A, B.com, BMS, BBA etc) are no more dependent only on the boards marks at higher secondary level. Admissions to these institutions now also look into student's performance in CUET - Common University Entrance Test (UG) organised by National Testing Agency (NTA). The National Testing Agency has been mandated by the Ministry of Education and UGC to conduct the Common University Entrance Test (CUET) for admission into Undergraduate Programmes in Central Universities under the Ministry of Education, and other participating Universities / Institutions / Organizations / Autonomous Colleges. The CUET (UG) provides a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organisations (including State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities) across the Country.

For the Academic Session 2024-25, CUET (UG) 2024 is expected to be conducted between 15th May to 31st May, 2024. Applications are open and students can do online submission of Application form till 26th March, 2024 in the official website of NTA.

CUET Exam Pattern:

All Questions are of MCQ pattern

Exam would be conducted in Hybrid mode [Computer based test (CBT) or Pen & paper]

Exam would be conducted in 13 languages including English and Assamese

There are three sections in the paper:

Section 1 - Language Test (33 different options)

Section 2 - Domain Test (27 subjects option)

Section 3 - General Test

Details about CUET exam have been informed to all the class 12 students of our school by a career guidance session done by Shri Dinesh Lahoti (Career Coach)

In this crash course, students will be trained on Section 1 (English Language Test) and Section 3 (General Ability Test).
